## CROCHET HOOK

4mm (no 8) (US 6) crochet hook

## CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

**Ch** = chain; **tr** = treble; **sp(s)** = space(s); **sl st** = slip stitch.

## HORIZONTAL WEAVING

The mesh “grid” of the main scarf now has stripes overlaid on to it by the vertical weaving lines. To complete the check effect at each end of the scarf, lengths of chain are now woven in and out of the vertical stripes and grid lines.

For each horizontal weaving line, using a 4mm (US 6) hook, start by making a length of ch that is slightly wider than the width of the scarf but do not fasten off. Leaving the yarn attached will allow the length to be adjusted correctly once it has been woven in – you can either unpick a few ch or work a few more. Threading the length of ch through the work from beginning of the ch will make this easier. Each length of ch is woven through the work along the lines of the rows, taking it alternatively over and under each tr or weaving line. Once each weaving ch has been woven through, adjust the length of the ch as required and fasten off and sew in ends.

## BOTH ENDS ALIKE

Starting above foundation/last row work towards the centre.

**Row 1:** Using yarn A & D held together, make a length of ch and weave this **under** each tr and **over** each vertical line.

**Row 2:** Using yarn B & F held together, make a length of ch and weave this **over** each tr and **under** each vertical line.

**Row 3:** Using yarn B & F held together, make a length of ch and weave this **under** each tr and **over** each vertical line.

**Row 4:** Using yarn B & E held together, make a length of ch and weave this **over** each tr and **under** each vertical line.

**Row 5:** Using yarn A & D held together, make a length of ch and weave this **under** each tr and **over** each vertical line.

**Row 6:** Using yarn B & E held together, make a length of ch and weave this **over** each tr and **under** each vertical line.

**Row 7:** Using yarn B & E held together, make a length of ch and weave this **under** each tr and **over** each vertical line.

**Row 8:** Using yarn A & D held together, make a length of ch and weave this **over** each tr and **under** each vertical line.

**Row 9:** Using yarn B & E held together, make a length of ch and weave this **under** each tr and **over** each vertical line.

**Row 10:** Using yarn B & F held together, make a length of ch and weave this **over** each tr and **under** each vertical line.

**Row 11:** Using yarn A & D held together, make a length of ch and weave this **under** each tr and **over** each vertical line.

**Row 12:** Using yarn A & D held together, make a length of ch and weave this **over** each tr and **under** each vertical line.

**Row 13:** Using yarn B & E held together, make a length of ch and weave this **under** each tr and **over** each vertical line.

**Row 14:** Using yarn B & E held together, make a length of ch and weave this **over** each tr and **under** each vertical line.

**Row 15:** Using yarn B & F held together, make a length of ch and weave this **under** each tr and **over** each vertical line.

**Row 16:** Using yarn A & D held together, make a length of ch and weave this **over** each tr and **under** each vertical line.

**Row 17 – 21:** as rows 1 – 5.

## FRINGING

Using same shades as in Vertical stripes make 3 lengths 40cm long, double over and attach to 2ch sp on foundation/last row by inserting doubled over end then threading rest of yarn through, tighten to secure.
